


many tradition-bound Hindu homes, children are made to say prayers and bhajans at dusk. Christians go to church at least once a week and in many orthodox homes offer prayers (grace) before each meal. Such practices are beneficial for developing will power. I would like to make it clear that while advocating the efficacy of prayers, I do not assert or deny the existence of God.

Some people observe fasts for

sixteen Thursdays to propitiate Dattaguru; some observe fasts on Fridays to propitiate Santoshi Mata. I have no comments to make on the religious aspects of these fasts. But I would like to



assure you that such selfdenials develop will power. Muslims, who fast during Ramzan can develop will power out of this exercise. Eating is a basic human need. If a person can deny this to himself, he develops will power. The Ekadashi used to be observed by Hindus by having only one meal on Dashami (the tenth day) and fasting on Ekadashi (the eleventh day). In addition, they were supposed to abstain from sleeping on

the day of Ekadashi. Thus they denied themselves the basic human needs of food as well as sleep. Since this was done only on one day of the fortnight, it did not leave any harmful physiological effects. As for the mind, denial of food and

sleep developed will power.

Those who intend to develop will power by fasting should ensure that their bowels are clean before they undertake a fast. They must also take plenty of water (or fruit juice) to avoid auto-intoxication. It is advisable to consult the family physician. If you fast scientifically, it is good for health too.

































# Little World of Mud

From the desk of Ruskin Bond

had never thought there was much to be found in the rainwater pond behind our bungalow in north India, except for quantities of mud and the occasional water buffalo. It was Grandfather who introduced me to the pond's diversity of life, so beautifully arranged that each individual gained some benefit from the well being of the others. To the inhabitants of the pond, the pond was the world; and to the inhabitants of the world, commented Grandfather, the world was just a muddy pond

When Grandfather first showed me the pond world, he chose a dry place in the shade of an old peepul tree, where we sat for an hour, gazing steadily at the thin green scum on the water. The buffaloes had not arrived for their afternoon dip, and the surface of the pond was undisturbed.

For the first ten minutes we saw nothing. Then a small black blob appeared in the middle of the pond. Gradually it rose higher; until at last we could make out a frog's head, its big eyes staring hard at us. The frog did not know if we were friends or enemy so he kept his body out of sight. A heron, his mortal enemy, might have been wading about in search of a meal.

When Mr. Frog had made sure that we were not herons, he passed this information on to his friends and neighbours, and very soon there were a number of big heads and eyes on the surface of the water. Throats swelled. We were treated to a chorus that went, "wurk, wurk, wurk, wurk...."

In the shallow water near the tree we could see a dark shifting shadow. When I touched it with the end of a stick, the dark mass immediately became alive. Thousands of little black

tadpoles wriggled into life, pushing and hustling each other. "What do tadpoles eat?" I asked.


"They eat one another most of the time," said Grandfather. "It may seen an unpleasant custom, but if all the young tadpoles in this pond grew into frogs they would take up every inch of the ground between here and the house. And they'd be all over the bedrooms and the bathrooms and the kitchen. Your grandmother wouldn't be too pleased."

"Their croaking would drive her crazy!"

Grandfather told me that when he was a young man he had once brought home a number of green tree-frogs. He put them in a glass jar and left them on a windowsill without telling anyone of their presence.

At about four in the morning the entire household was awakened by a loud and fearful noise, Grandmother and other members of the household gathered on the verandah for safety. Their fear turned to outrage when they discovered the source of all the noise. At the first glimmer of dawn the frogs had with one accord burst into song. Grandmother wanted them thrown out of the window, but Grandfather gave the bottle a good shaking and that guietened them for some time. Everyone went back to sleep, but Grandfather was obliged to stay awake in order to shake the bottle whenever the frogs showed signs of bursting into sona.

ost of you must be interested in games like cricket, football, hockey, basketball, tennis and so on. But there are a number of other games, ones played indoors, which are very popular among people, children



in particular. They are simple and can also generate a great deal of fun. We have all played games like Ludo, Snakes and Ladders. As a child I remember not

Many of these games are board games, in which the players move their pieces or markers on a



special board. They follow certain predetermined rules and are particularly popular: They have a long history, and exist in every culture. They range from games of skill and strategy, such as chess, to more simple games of chance, like Ludo and Snakes and Ladders, where a throw of the dice determines the winner. G0, also known as WEI - CH'I, is more than 4000 years old. It is extremely popular in South East Asia, especially in China, Japan and Korea. Players capture areas of the board by surrounding them with their own pieces.

DRAUGHTS and MANCALAH are ancient games of skill that originated in Africa. Mancalah is played with pebbles.

BACK GAMMON is a fast-paced game invented in Asia 5,000 years ago. It draws on both skill and chance, and is most popular around the Mediterranean. The first player to remove all his

His first 3D game, Bugs Bunny: Lost in Time, is an action-adventure that tries to capture the humor and spirit for which he's so well known.

The plot of Lost in Time-is extremely simple, just like most Looney Tunes skits. Bugs has taken another wrong turn on

# CIVILIZATION: CALL TO POWER II



he game lays claim to expanding the traditional timeline of the Civilization game, spanning 6000 years from prehistory to 2300 AD. The gameplay is very much the same as it ever was, being familiar to those who have played the original Civilization Call to Power and Alpha Centauri. However,

the original Call to Power was doomed by its sacrifice of the

Civilization-style attention to details and intricate balance for a more global approach to empire management. Activision realises its mistake, and in announcing Call to Power II, it took the opportunity to illustrate the changes in the upcoming game. Combat, for one, will be "refined and rebalanced for

more realistic outcomes." Also, advanced units will now have more obvious tactical superiority over primitive units, cutting down on the more ridiculous episodes of axewielding cavemen trouncing 20th-century paratroopers.

In Civilization: Call to Power, we have the answer to what some would call the single-most daunting challenge in PC gaming: to design the direct heir to Civilization II, widely regarded as the best turn-based strategy game of all time. Whatever else you may think about Call to Power, you have

to admire the ambition behind the effort. This is not a mere rehash of Civilization II. Rather, it is a bold step in a new and


at times almost entirely different direction. The designers took the opportunity to revisit almost every major aspect of the Civ II experience - units, combat, interface, graphics, and more.



While superficial similarities exist, in truth, Civilization: Call to Power bears less resemblance to Civilization II than Civilization II did to the original Civilization.

# DAVERPORT BROUGHT MARTINA

he hard-hitting American, Lindsay Davenport brought Swiss Miss Martina Hingis to her knees in Melbourne. The story of the women's champion in Australian open is in some ways similar to the Agassi saga. Nobody doubted Davenport's shotmaking talents but she carried considerable excess baggage and fitter players took advantage of that before the Californian decided to shed weight, train hard and

Rewards came quickly, the first big one at the U.S. Open two years ago. And, since then Davenport has been a genuine world-beater, adding the Wimbledon crown last summer and the Australian here last fortnight.

"I play tennis because I love the sport. I don't do it for attention or for money or for anything eise," said Davenport, 23, after beating Martina Hingis 6-1, 7-5 in the women's final for her fourth straight victory over the Swiss world No.1

"I've been lucky I have gotten this good at tennis and I have worked really hard to get it," said Davenport, who thanked her longtime coach Robert Van't Hof for helping her become the champion she is. "Robert has done so much for me. Without him I don't know where I will be." It is very obvious that Hingis' game doesn't match up very well with Davenport's. The American has been able to overpower the Swiss teenager time after time, and on all surfaces.





## ICC Revokes Power of Its Own Advisory Panel!

The International Cricket Council (ICC), in a landmark decision, announced it had revoked the powers of its own advisory panel to ban bowlers with suspect actions. ICC President Jagmohan Dalmiya stated that the decision was made at a two-day executive board meeting in Singapore. The decision will reinstate Pakistan paceman Shoaib Akhtar in Test cricket.

Shoaib Akhtar is currently barred from playing Test cricket because of a flawed bowling action, though he was cleared last month to play one-day internationals for Pakistan. The ICC chief explained his decision. The ICC's advisory panel on illegal deliveries would ``no longer ban a player with a suspect action until such time as there has been a full review by the ICC of that power and related procedures."

Replying to questions, Dalmiya explained that pressure would now be on the respective national bodies to take action when the panel reported a bowler with a "suspect" action. With regard to Shoaib Akhtar, the ICC president said: "Pakistan will report the progress on the work on the bowler's action and this will then be reviewed by the panel.

"If further correction is required, then the panel will advise the Pakistani Cricket board accordingly. It is then up to Pakistan to take Shoaib Akhtar out of its international squad."

# Triumph at the Under-19 World Cup



ndian juniors won the under-19 world cup in Sri Lanka beating the host nation comfortably. Set a target of 179 to win the Indian juniors won easily.

The future is the key. It is easy to be euphoric about a very creditable performance. But the question now is how to build

for the future from here.

While India's triumph at the second ICC under-19 World Cup in Sri Lanka is indeed heart-warming, the familiarity with the conditions was an advantage which cannot be easily discounted.

The junior World Cup was essentially a race between the powerhouses of the sub-continent, all three of which made it to the semifinals. India's superiority over the rest arose from the fact that it fielded a far-experienced composition, with



almost all of them first class cricketers.

The unfortunate exit of South Africa and the surprise qualification of Nepal made things much easier for Sri Lanka and India in the Super-Eight Group II. Defending champion England was no force in these conditions while the spirited Reetinder Singh Sodhi, who made 74 after the side was trickily placed at 74 for three, was the success factor in the outing against Sri Lanka which enabled the side top the group.

India went into the final with a psychological edge having beaten Sri Lanka in each one of their previous five meetings over two seasons. India won convincingly, the overall experience providing the cutting edge.



The upper age limit is relaxable by five years for SC/ST candidates and three years for OBC. The candidates are required to meet certain physical standards. 




