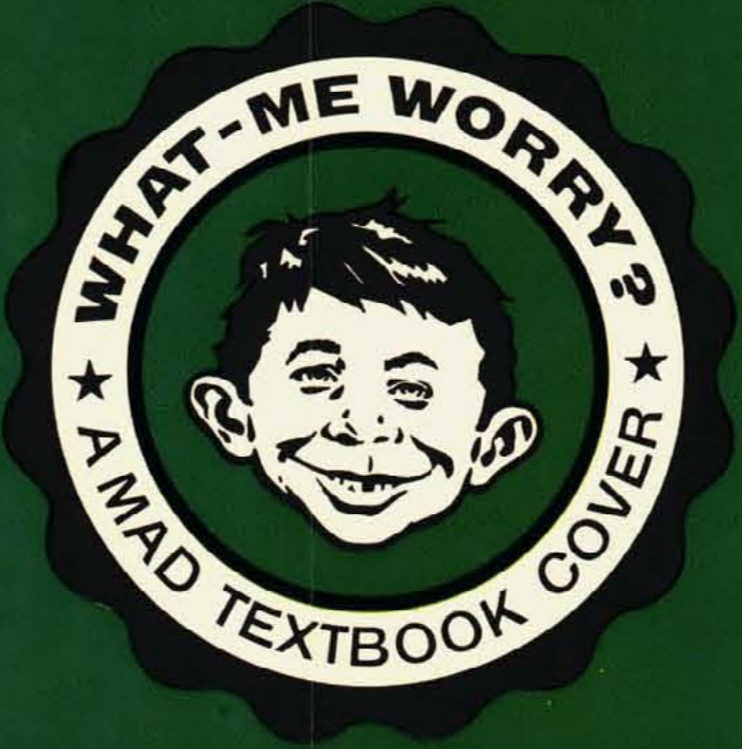

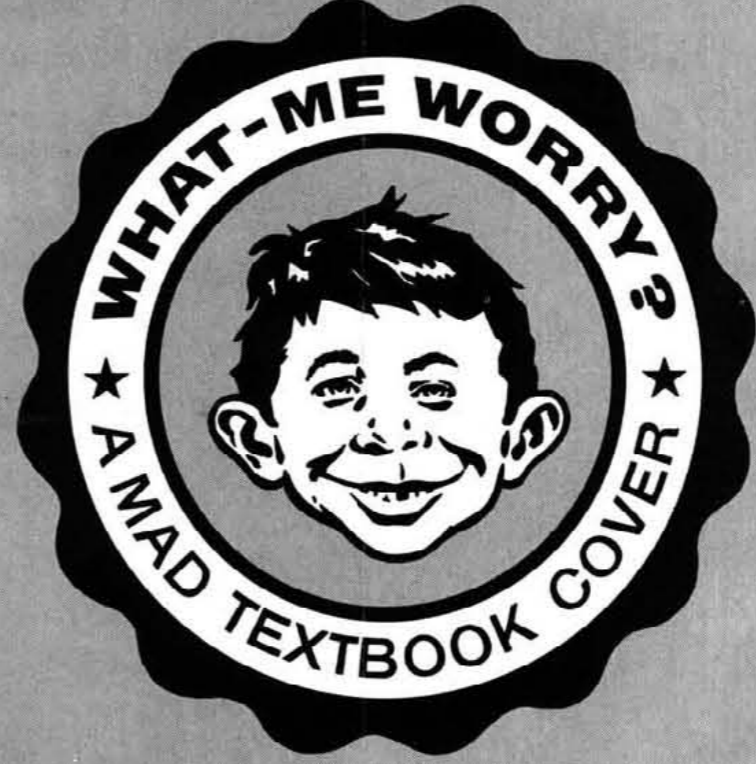

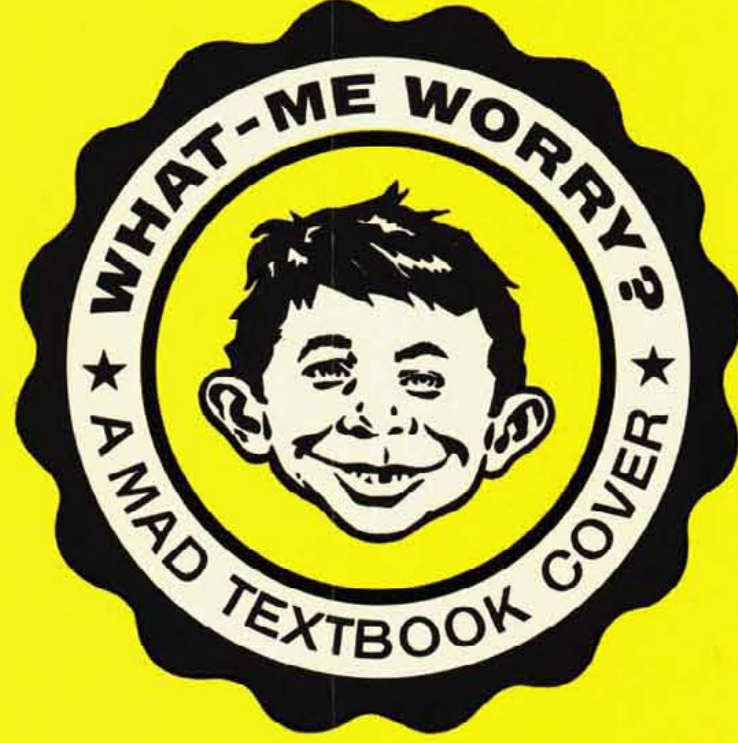

LAWS OF PHYSICS**

1. A body at rest remains at rest, and a body in motion was probably kicked out of bed by his mother.

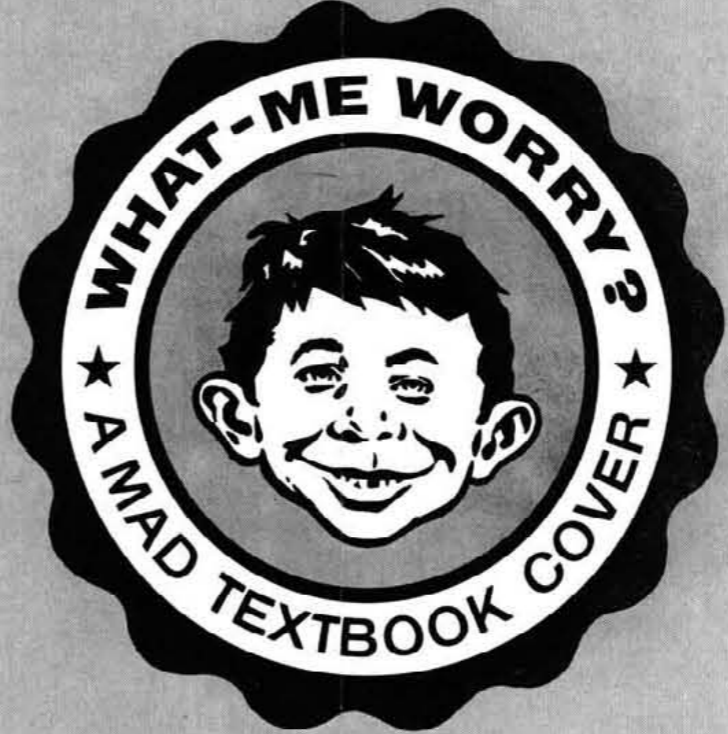

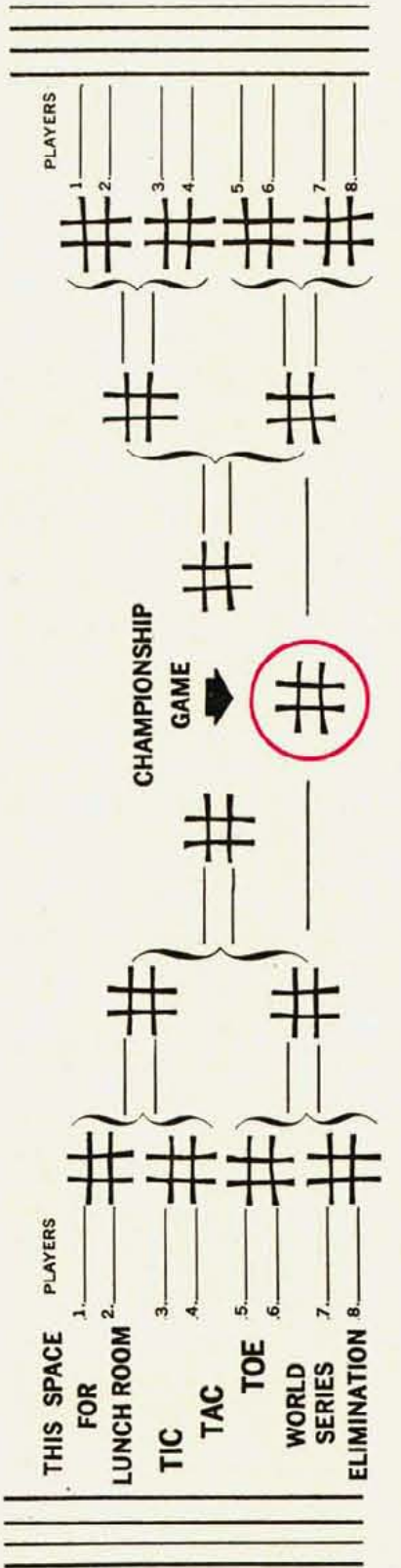
