Think critically and carefully when assessing the physical aspects of others.









A professional workplace must be maintained for the good of the crew.


Horseplay should be kept to recreation areas only. A commander is loath to reiterate such basic rules, but crew behavior dictates that it must be done.





stay vigilant.


Dealing with an omnipotent being who can bend time and space can be exhausting.



Put your energies into raising up those without a voice instead of acquiring trinkets.







## LISTEN TO THE CONCERNS OF YOUR CREW.

It also prevents conspiracy.












Don't wait until the death of civilization to discover your hidden talent. Leadership is a taxing station. Handling intergalactic business takes its toll.


