





ONPOINT

One of the Christmas season's showiest plants, poinsettias make fabulous indoor decorations and are a great alternative to cut flowers. While they were traditionally best known in scarlet red, the range of colours has expanded hugely and these days covers cream, yellow, white and multiple shades of pink, including some lovely two-tone variations. The showy 'flowers' of poinsettias are actually modified leaves (known as bracts), which explains why they last so long, the true flowers are the cluster of small buds in the centre. If you buy them as potted plants now, you can enjoy many weeks of colour indoors, before repotting, cutting back and giving them a spell outside.

GROWING ON

While they're happy indoors for a few weeks, poinsettias are not long-term house plants. They need to be moved outdoors if you want to keep them growing and they must have a frost-free climate – tropical, subtropical and warm temperate zones suit them best. After the flowers have faded, trim plants back and repot into fresh potting mix. Place in a warm sunny spot, keep well watered and feed occasionally with a liquid fertiliser. If the conditions are right, you can enjoy another colourful display in mid-winter.

TRICKS OF THE TRADE

In the wild, poinsettias bloom naturally in the winter months. To produce them for Christmas time in Australia, they are grown in light-controlled greenhouses. By extending the period of night-time darkness, plants are coaxed into early bloom.









PLANTER OF PURE JOY

For a personalised planter, découpage a papier-mâché lidded box with decorative paper in tones of your poinsettia's colour. Measure circumference of box plus 1cm, and height plus 5cm. Use these measurements to cut out paper. Lay box on its side, then coat a section with découpage medium and a sponge brush before placing paper on top (with 2.5cm overhang at top and bottom) and smoothing it in place. Continue gluing paper around box, noting end of paper should overlap starting edge. Snip into excess paper at corners of box; fold excess paper inside box and underneath box, and secure with découpage medium. Coat box with medium to seal it. Let dry.




IT'S IN THE BAG

Do you have an abundance of paper grocery bags? This project ensures your bags are destined for more than the recycling bin! To make this bright pot cover, cut a 38 x 65cm piece out of the bag. Roll into a ball to crinkle it, open out and lay it flat. Apply pink paint (or colour to match poinsettias) to one side. When dry, rub gold lustre (try Rub'n Buff). Hot glue 38 x 65cm piece of gold crepe paper to unpainted side. Form a tube, overlapping and gluing ends. For base of cover, at one open end of tube, fold opposite sides to the middle, overlap slightly and hot glue. Fold and glue remaining two 'points' at sides in the middle. Roll top of bag down to right side for a contrasting cuff.



FOREVER FLOWERS

Crepe paper has the characteristics to mimic poinsettia bracts so well, you almost can't tell these tree decorations aren't the real thing. Follow the instructions and templates to create your poinsettias and, once you get the hang of it, you'll be able to churn them out quickly. Then all you need is a dab of glass glitter in the centre. The tape-wrapped florist wire stems make it easy to attach them to your tree. At the end of the season, store in loosely wrapped these paper in a waterproof box, and they'll last for several years to come.





If your ideal Christmas looks like the interior of a snow globe, this wreath is for you.

2 THE BASE

Flock a plain wreath by spraying it with water, sprinkling on flocking powder and spritzing


Divide flat plastic snowflakes into two equal groups. Cut one

effect. Coat snowflakes in spray adhesive and sprinkle with glass glitter. Attach florist wire to snowflakes and insert in wreath.

skewers into foam balls to create picks. Brush foam balls of different sizes with PVA glue, then dip in glitter, faux snow or flocking powder.









wonder

2 GATHER

You'll need faux nests, birdies, berry branches/ picks (found online) and an evergreen wreath.

Create a festive, frosted look by coating berries and leaves with spray adhesive, then dipping in glass glitter. Better tip: Create a spray booth, 40 x 40cm or larger. Tape one side closed and keep one side open toward you. Spray and

box to keep adhesive and glitter corralled.

4 ATTACH + ARRANGE

Once the glitter has set, cut the ends of the berry branches/picks with wire cutters. Twist florist wire onto the nests and birds. Attach all items to

the berries evenly throughout and placing the nests near the bottom.

5 TIE ON A BOW

Use wide red satin ribbon to tie a simple floppy bow to the wreath, as shown (left).



Coastal charm

Covered in gifts from the sea, this wreath sets a serene scene for any who come 'aboard'.

1THE BIGIDEA

Subtly decorated on top and lushly covered on the bottom, this is what a wreath might look like if the tide washed over it, leaving lovely beachy treasures behind.

2GOBLUE

A blue spruce wreath carries the ocean colour scheme. If need be, lightly spray a faux evergreen wreath blue.

3 GATHER

Think low-tide treasures
– driftwood (it's really a
grapewood branch from
Amazon), tiny round
matt ornaments similar
to pearls, and seashells,
sand dollars and starfish
covered in green and
blue glitter. Regular
glue won't cut it. Brush
strong, tacky craft
glue onto items, then
shake glitter on top.

4 ATTACH

Hot glue a wooden skewer onto the back of the pieces to help hold the items in place.

5 ARRANGE

Glue driftwood around bottom half to two thirds of the wreath. Add each shell, sticking skewers into wreath and securing with florist wire and hot glue. Attach large shells at the bottom, getting smaller and sparser towards the top. Finish by wiring on clusters of 'pearl' ornaments.

CHRISTMAS STONE FRUIT CHUTNEY

Preparation time 25 mins Cooking time 1½ hours Makes 3½ kg (7 jars)

3kg stone fruit, peeled (we used a mixture of peaches and nectarines)
3 red onions, diced
2 cups raw sugar
8cm piece ginger, finely grated
4cm piece turmeric, finely grated
2 long red chillies, deseeded and very finely chopped
1 Tbsp curry powder
2 tsp ground cinnamon
1 tsp ground cloves
2 tsp fine salt
2 cups apple cider vinegar
2 tsp yellow mustard seeds
1kg jam-setting sugar

STEP 1 Chop stone fruit into ½cm dice. Combine 2kg of the chopped fruit in a large saucepan with 2 of the onions, sugar, ginger, turmeric, chilli, curry powder, cinnamon, cloves, salt and vinegar. Cook on medium heat and bring to a simmer. Simmer, uncovered for 45 minutes, stirring regularly.

STEP 2 Meanwhile, in a small frying pan

on low heat, cook mustard seeds for 4-5 minutes until toasted. Transfer to a mortar and pestle, and crack lightly. Add to simmering fruit mixture. Once mixture has thickened, add jam-setting sugar, increase heat to high and boil rapidly for 10 minutes. Fold in remaining stone fruit and onion.

STEP 3 Spoon into jars while hot, place a square of baking paper over top, then fit lid tightly. Put a tea towel in base of a saucepan of boiling water that covers jars by at least 3cm, then place jars in it. Simmer on low for 30 minutes to preserve, then carefully remove and ensure lids are tight. Put jars upside down on a wire rack and allow to cool completely without moving. Store in a cool, dark place for up to 3 months.

Drizzle with oil. Season with salt. STEP 2 Put pork on a small rack in a roasting tray and roast for 20 minutes. Reduce heat to 160°C fan-forced (180°C conventional) and roast for 21/2 hours. Increase heat to 220°C fan-forced (240°C conventional) roast for 20 minutes. Set aside to rest for 15 minutes. STEP 3 Meanwhile, steam pumpkin until tender. Press through sieve, discard solids, combine with caster sugar, sesame oil, turmeric and paprika in a saucepan on medium heat. Cook for 10 minutes, stirring, until thickened. Season. STEP 4 Combine vinegar, brown sugar, cinnamon, star anise and cloves in a saucepan on medium heat, simmer for 10 minutes. Strain. Return to saucepan. Mix arrowroot with 1 tablespoon of water, whisk into vinegar mixture, simmer until thickened. Carve pork and serve with

pumpkin sauce, vinegar and vegetables.

PRAWN COCKTAIL SLIDERS

Preparation time 40 mins Cooking time 10 mins Makes 10

½ cup mayonnaise
 1 Tbsp tomato sauce
 2 tsp sriracha sauce
 Juice of 1½ limes
 2 Tbsp pickled jalapeños, finely chopped
 ¾ bunch chives, finely sliced
 Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper, to season
 10 small brioche buns
 Butter lettuce, sliced avocado and lime wedges, to serve

PRAWN AND FISH PATTIES

300g raw prawn meat (approx. 12 large prawns), very finely sliced

5 green onions, white part only, very finely sliced

20g ginger, finely grated

1 Tbsp light soy sauce

1 Tbsp white rice vinegar

450g flathead or ling fillets, bones and skin removed, diced

1/2 tsp sesame oil

2 tsp salt flakes

1 Tbsp caster sugar

2 free-range egg whites, plus 1 extra, whisked

100ml cream, chilled

1/4 cup white sesame seeds

1/4 cup vegetable oil

STEP 1 To make sauce, mix mayonnaise, tomato sauce, sriracha and lime juice together. Stir through jalapeños and chives. Season and refrigerate until needed.

STEP 2 To make Prawn and fish patties, combine sliced prawn meat,

green onion, ginger, soy and rice vinegar in a non-metallic bowl. Cover. Refrigerate until needed. STEP 3 Add diced fish to a chilled food processor bowl. Pulse to a soft mince and add sesame oil, salt and sugar. Then add egg whites and blitz to combine well. Add chilled cream and puree to make a smooth mousse. Transfer mixture to a large bowl, then fold in marinated prawn mixture. STEP 4 Roll 1/2 cupfuls of mixture into balls. Dip each patty into whisked extra egg white, then coat in white sesame seeds and press to flatten. Refrigerate for 15 minutes to firm slightly. When ready to cook, heat oil in a frying pan on medium heat. Cook patties in batches for about 3 minutes on each side or until cooked through.

STEP 5 Top buns with sauce, lettuce, avocado, prawn patties, more sauce and bun tops. Serve with lime wedges.



MISO FISH WITH DAIKON AND FRIED GINGER

Preparation time 20 mins plus 2 hours marinating
Cooking time 15 mins
Serves 4

120g white miso paste

3 Tbsp mirin

2 Tbsp sake

1 Tbsp sesame oil

4 x 200g fish fillets (such as blue-eye), skin on, bones removed

1 bunch asparagus, sliced on an angle

1 Tbsp vegetable oil, plus extra, for shallow frying

150g sugar snap peas, trimmed and halved lengthways

300g daikon, peeled and finely julienned

8cm piece ginger, peeled and julienned

1½ Tbsp white sesame seeds, lightly toasted

1/2 sheet roasted nori, finely snipped

YUZU DRESSING

¼ cup light soy sauce
 ¼ cup yuzu juice
 ½ tsp ground white pepper
 100ml extra virgin olive oil
 1½ tsp caster sugar

STEP 1 Combine miso, mirin, sake and sesame oil in a bowl. Rub over fish in a non-metallic dish. Refrigerate, covered, for at least 2 hours.

STEP 2 For the Yuzu dressing, combine all ingredients in a bowl and set aside.

STEP 3 Toss asparagus in vegetable oil and cook on high heat in a frypan for 1-2 minutes, tossing, until lightly coloured. Transfer asparagus to a bowl and toss with sugar snaps, daikon and yuzu dressing.

STEP 4 Heat 3cm of extra oil in a large frypan on medium heat. Fry ginger until lightly golden, remove from oil, transfer to a plate lined with paper towel (ginger will crisp as it cools).

STEP 5 Preheat oven grill on high. Wipe excess marinade off fish with paper towel and scatter fish with sesame seeds.

STEP 6 Put fish on a foil-lined baking tray, skin side up. Grill for 5 to 6 minutes until skin is well-coloured. Remove tray from oven and rest fish for 2 minutes (it will continue to cook through while resting).

STEP 7 Serve fish with asparagus salad, topped with fried ginger and nori.

Apply liquid fertiliser in autumn and summer.

WHAT'S A TILLANDSIA?

These are also known as air plants because they don't need soil to grow - the soil, or sand, is just used to support them. They originate from the humid tropical regions of Central America where they grow on other plants, drawing their nutrients and moisture from the air. You can imitate their origins by growing them on clean driftwood or logs, and place them where they get indirect sunlight. If your atmosphere is relatively dry, spray with water every week.



From seeds, to seedlings, to a vegie patch filled with sweet, tasty produce – all it takes is love and attention



ou've sown your seeds, watered them, kept them sheltered, then two tiny leaves emerge from the deep. These are called cotyledons, or seed leaves, and in no way resemble the mature plant's leaf shape. They've taken up energy stored in the seed to grow and their function is to photosynthesize and return energy to the seed so roots grow and 'true' leaves can form. Once this happens, the cotyledons drop off and you have a seedling. Your journey to filling your pantry with fresh vegies now begins.



RAISING YOUR SEEDLINGS

Seedlings need their growing mix to be consistently moist, but not soggy, as this can encourage pests or fungal attacks. The best way is to water from below so you don't damage the delicate seedlings – put your seedling cells or jiffy pots into a large tray and fill with enough water to cover the holes in the bottom of the pots so the water will be absorbed up.

If you covered your cells or pots with a

clear lid or cling wrap after you sowed the seeds, now is the time to give them ventilation. Prop up one side of the lid by about 3cm or poke a few holes in the cling wrap. Lift the lid a little more, or poke more holes in the cling wrap every couple of days until the lid is entirely open and the cling wrap is looking tatty, then remove it altogether. You need to check daily that the growing mix is still moist.

Once the true leaves appear and if you have several seedlings in a cell, you need to thin out the strugglers, as they are all competing for water and nutrients.

Start feeding them liquid fertiliser at the strength recommended on the label. Use natural organic fertiliser as synthetic chemicals can burn seedlings.

When seedlings have developed their second set of true leaves,

move them into indirect sunlight in a spot sheltered from wind and rain to harden them up. Put them into direct sunlight for a few hours, then increase the sun dosage each day thereafter. This new environment means you need to check the moisture more frequently as the growing mix will dry out more quickly.

Once the seedlings are twice as tall as the

cell or pot, they need to be transplanted to a bigger home - either a large pot or a garden bed. Enrich vour soil with organic matter, digging it in to create air cavities. Create a hole with a trowel or dibber and, if you're growing in a jiffy pot, just put seedling and pot together in their new home. If not, ever so gently remove seedlings from cell, without pulling on the stem, and plant into the bed. Plants suffer transplant shock when they're moved and seedlings are very vulnerable.

Water the soil - not the seedlings.

Cover seedlings with netting or cloches as seedlings are much sought after by possums as delicacies. Importantly, follow growing instructions on the seed packets.

GO FESTIVE

- · Make a front door wreath with flowers from your garden, your local florist, buy artificial ones, or a mix of all three.
- · Light garden pathways with twinkling solar lights and display a group of grazing reindeer at the far end.
- Share the Christmas spirit and adorn your letterbox with a big red bow and tinsel.
- Set up an outdoor Chrissie tree and decorate it with LED fairy lights.
- Plant colourful annuals such as petunias and calibrachoas in an old wheelbarrow, first ensuring that it has plenty of drainage holes.

Christmas Day comes but once a year, so you can afford to be creative indoors. Design a table centrepiece of silver or gold spray-painted pine cones, or go for a bush-themed table setting of gum leaves, gumnuts

and a fire engine red grevillea bloom. Make place setting name tags using crisp white card and pressed flowers, and fill vases with brilliantly coloured red native bottlebrush, hibiscus or poinsettia.



GO GREEN

Rather than pulling out your tired artificial tree this festive season, go green instead, with a real, living Christmas tree.

- Practically any potted tree can be used, but among the best are the Douglas fir (Pseudotsuga menziesii), the conical dwarf white spruce (Picea glauca 'Conica') and the silver-blue Norway spruce (Picea abies) - or for an Aussie touch, the Wollemi pine.
- Choose a smallish specimen, decorate its pot in a Christmas theme, water occasionally and it's good to remain indoors for several days. You can even keep it in its pot outdoors for a few follow-up Christmases before planting it in the garden.



A CRIMSON BEAUTY

The spectacular NSW waratah (Telopeα speciosissima), which is the state's floral emblem, has a temperamental image. This crimson beauty is a fussy bloomer, sometimes in the wild not flowering more than once or twice in five years. Thankfully, newer domesticated strains are more reliable if given morning sun and free-draining though slightly moist, sandy soil. Some growers add bush litter believing it supplies beneficial organisms to the plant.



GARDEN SECRETS

How to grow an easy stepover apple tree

1

STEPPING OUT

You can step over these knee-high, space-saving apple trees. They're both visually stunning and highly practical – but they need training. 2

T-SHAPE

Buy ready-grafted stepover trees and grow espalier-style in a T shape along a wire 45cm high, supported on stakes 1.5m apart. Eliminate lower foliage. 3

GROWING ARMS

Cut off stem's top section just below wire, leaving healthy buds near top. Encourage two strongest upper shoots to form "arms" and attach with soft ties.



APPLES AT YOUR FINGERTIPS.

GARDENING ADVICE

CUT BACK herbs that have run to seed. **TOP UP** mulch on garden beds and in pots. **TRIM** repeat-flowering roses that have already bloomed to encourage an autumn show.

NET fruit trees to deter birds, possums, rabbits, rodents



How to use the calendar

Best days Second-best days

On these days, thin out seed boxes, sow all types of seeds and plant seedlings that produce their crop above the ground. These include all varieties of peas, beans, corn, cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli, Brussels sprout, eggplant, lettuce, celery, silverbeet, spinach, endive, Chinese cabbage, tomato, cucumber, asparagus crowns, artichoke, marrow, pumpkin, capsicum, melon, zucchini, chicory, sprouts, rhubarb, all herbs (except garlic) and all agricultural crops, such as sunflower, grains, cereals, canola and cotton. During these days, you can also plant flowering shrubs, annuals, flowers (not bulbs), cactus, flax, tree ferns, passionfruit vines and kiwifruit. Plant all fruit trees and trees that produce edible nuts, such as almond, pecan, macadamia and walnut. Grapes and banana can also be planted during these times. Take cuttings from established trees and shrubs, and propagate. This is also a good time for planting trees and climbers and sowing new lawns.

Best days Second-best days

On these days, sow all seeds and plant seedlings of root vegetables that grow their crop below the ground, such as carrot, parsnip, radish, beetroot, onion, leek, swede, turnip, sweet potato, seed potato, yam, cassava, peanut, garlic and ginger. This is a good time to plant flowering bulbs, or bulbs for propagation and development rather than flowers. Also, plant bare-rooted trees, to develop root growth, and refurbish established lawns.

- A favourable time for transplanting all types of established trees, shrubs, ferns and bulbs.
- Weed and lightly feed. Water with seaweed-type products only.
- Destroy or spray weeds, pests and noxious growth. Burn off, cut lawns, do heavy pruning and clear rubbish don't plant or transplant anything. Prepare soil and fertilise garden beds for future planting; spread and make compost; feed all established plants, shrubs and lawns, then water in. This is the best time for dethatching or coring lawns.
- Do not plant or transplant anything, as the moon is adversely aspected with the sun.

EASY STEPS TO CREATING GIANT BELLS AND BAUBLES

Go big or go home with these gorgeous oversized patio ornaments, made from plant pots. They'll help you ring in the party season without putting a dent in your wallet.

Gather your supplies

- Lotus 19 x 16.5cm
 black plastic plant
 pot (20)
- Painter's 48mm masking tapeHot glue gun
- 6mm natural jute cord
- Blue hot-melt glue stick
- Plastic primer spray
- Flat black spray paint
 - Rust-effect spray paint in Bronze
 - Paint trav
- Copper plant labels with ties
 - Gold spray paint
 - Green ribbon

You'll also need

Gloves; safety goggles; mask; wide paintbrush; scissors; takeaway plastic bowls





Here's how

STEP 1 Apply a strip of painter's masking tape around top of pot, about 5cm in from top edge.

STEP 2 Using hot glue gun, glue enough cord around top of pot, below tape, to meet cord end. Snip and press firmly to adhere.

STEP 3 Repeat Step 2 to glue cord around top part of tape. Allow to dry

STEP 4 Once glue is dry, remove tape from pot.

STEP 5 Insert a blue hot-melt stick into glue gun and draw a squiggle pattern around pot within cord border. Allow to dry.

STEP 6 Pull plug out of pot drainage hole. Cut a length of cord, 80cm, and thread through pot, then double it over. Hold cord up against pot to determine bell height, knot cord at this length. Thread cord through hole from inside and knot again on outside to hold in place.







STEP 7 Holding up cord to keep pot at a safe distance, spray plastic primer over pot to cover (wear gloves and mask). Allow to dry, approx. 10 minutes.

STEP 8 Spray pot with flat black paint to cover. Hang in an open area, allow to dry.

STEP 9 Spray bronze rust-effect paint onto tray. Skim paint over pot with brush, starting at squiggle border and working around

pot. Continue painting around pot until covered. **STEP 10** For bell cord, thread tie through hole on copper plant label and knot. Twist other end of tie around jute cord to secure. Repeat for other bells.

EASY STEPS TO BUILDING A LIVING GREEN CHANDELIER

Breathe in the minty, honey aroma of fresh gum leaves – so quintessentially Aussie!

Gather your supplies

- · Shallow bowl
- Rust-effect chain
- Black tie wire
- Selection of fresh gum branches and gumnuts
 - · Ceiling hook

You'll also need

Drill; 3mm drill bit, suitable for metal; long nose pliers; crimping tool; 100mm drill bit for timber

Note

Various laws in Australia protect native flora so rather than forage, buy your gum branches and gumnuts from a florist.







Here's how

STEP 1 Cut chain into 3 equal length pieces according to the drop from the ceiling you want.

spaced holes in bowl lip, 10mm from edge. Open last link in chains with crimper, push through holes and close around lip with pliers.

STEP 3 Drill 16 evenly spaced holes around top of bowl.

STEP 4 Thread black tie wire back and forth across bowl, starting at a shorter end going one way, running wire under lip to next hole, then going the other way. Tie both ends together and trim. STEP 5 Insert branches and nuts through wire, allowing them to spill over the sides. STEP 6 Drill hole for hook in ceiling rafter and screw hook to rafter, then loop chains through hook.



EASY STEPS TO MAKING A GIANT GREEN BAUBLE

Pluck herbs and salad greens straight from a handy hanging garden to your plate!

Gather your supplies

- Coir-lined metal hanging baskets (2)
 - Potting mix
 - Cable ties
- Selection of fresh leafy vegies and herbs

You'll also need

Newspaper or paper towels; scissors or craft knife; gloves

Here's how

STEP 1 Fill baskets with quality potting mix. Pack firm. STEP 2 Place baskets on newspaper and gently put one on top of the other. Expect some spillage. STEP 3 Wrap about 16 cable ties around metal rims to join, make secure, then trim excess ties. STEP 4 With scissors or craft knife, cut openings in coir where you want plants. STEP 5 Remove potting mix at opening the same

size as plant root ball. **STEP 6** Gently insert plant roots into openings. **STEP 7** Water well, pop in water tub for 30 minutes.










e ready! We're in for a long, hot summer and that means more time spent outdoors - in the shade! So, bring indoor comforts outside and provide bonus space for entertaining or just hanging out in style. But beautifying your backyard doesn't have to be timeconsuming or costly, from reviving time-worn wooden furniture and decking, to building a screen, adding a handy hot-tub shelf and putting up a towel hanger, you can easily turn your garden into a great venue.













FRESHEN UP YOUR OUTDOOR TABLE

Scrub table with degreaser and scrubbing brush to remove dirt, then rinse and allow to dry. Sand tabletop with orbital sander and 80-grit sandpaper. Use a sanding block with sandpaper to sand bevels and edges of slats. Remove dust, then wipe table with methylated spirits. Apply 2 coats exterior oil stain with paintbrush, allow to dry after each coat.

HANDY NOTE MERBAU MAGIC

· Beautiful, durable and rot- and termiteresistant, merbau is a great hardwood option for building garden accessories, but it is prone to bleeding tannin. If left untreated, it causes unsightly stains on surrounding materials. You can remove tannins from new merbau with a deck cleaner, scrubbing brush and hose. Follow directions on the packaging.

Whether you need extra privacy or to hide an eyesore, a merbau screen will tick all the boxes and add an extra dimension to elevate your outdoor space.

- 90 x 90mm 3m treated pine post (2)



STEP 4 Attach half stirrup anchor to Bottom batten at midpoint between End posts with decking screws.

STEP 5 Apply 2 coats exterior paint to screen frame. Allow to dry after each coat.

STEP 6 With an extra pair of hands, lift frame and insert the End posts and half stirrup anchor into the holes. Adjust frame to allow for a small gap between ground and Bottom batten (around 70mm). Ensure frame is level, square and plumb with level and hammer. Clamp frame into position.

STEP 7 Use bucket, shovel and hose to mix 2 bags of concrete at a time, as per packet instructions. Shovel concrete into all 3 holes until level with ground. Allow to set.





STEP 6 To assemble planter, lay 1 frame onto the prepared ground. Hammer frame into bed until level, then stack 2 frames onto the first (third frame with attached Cleats). Check edges are flush.

STEP 7 Predrill 6 equally spaced pilot holes into 8 Braces (start 20mm in from both ends). Attach 8 equally spaced Braces beneath the Cleats. Predrill through the holes, insert bugles and screw tight.

STEP 8 To complete planter frame, stack 2 rectangle frames onto the first 3. Lay 8 equally spaced Bed base components onto the Cleats, predrill, then insert bugles and screw tight. Attach a further 8 Braces to the upper section of the planter (using the same method as the lower Braces). Repeat Steps 6-8 to assemble second planter, with a 2230mm space between the planters. STEP 9 Cut steel for Steel facades (see list, page 132) with angle grinder. File sharp edges. Position Facades flush to top, use 3mm drill bit to drill 20mm in from edges and around perimeter with holes spaced around every

STEP 8

300mm. Insert nails and hammer nail flush.

STEP 10 Line beds with geotextile fabric. Fill with mushroom compost mixed with previously dug soil. **STEP 11** Install Planter cladding A and B to top of both planters. Predrill and insert 2 decking screws at ends, then space around every 300mm.

STEP 12 To assemble bench frame, form a rectangle with 2 Bench rails and 2 Bench struts (position struts within the rails). Predrill 2 pilot holes into end of Bench rail and into Bench strut, insert bugles and screw tight. Repeat for all corners. Using same method, assemble and attach remaining Struts so they are equally spaced within the bench frame. **STEP 13** To secure bench

STEP 13 To secure bench frame to planters, support bench in position (500mm down from top of planter). Predrill 3 equally spaced holes through end Strut and into planter. Insert bugles and screw tight. Repeat for opposite end. Check level.

STEP 14 To secure Cladding B, position flush to the bench front rail then use a 10G smart-bit to predrill 2 pilot holes 50mm from both ends and around every 400mm in between. Insert decking screws and screw tight.

Repeat process for bench top with all Cladding A components. Use a 5mm spacer between cladding.

STEP 15 Plant selection of plants and water in with hose.

Spread mulch around area.

Here's how

STEP 2 Apply and spread PVA glue along 1 long edge of both Top panels. Join panels flush, then clamp together and allow to set. Wipe excess PVA glue with damp cloth.

STEP 3 To prepare folding legs for assembly, use the profile of a Leg as a template to mark a half lap joint on both ends of both Bases. Repeat to mark half lap joint on one end of all Legs.

STEP 4 With combination square, mark 9mm depth of half lap joint on all Legs and Bases.

STEP 5 Saw a series of parallel cuts on all Leg- and Base-marked half lap joints with hand saw. Clamp to bench while cutting. Use chisel and hammer to cut away half lap joints on all Legs and Bases.





UNDERSIDE TEMPLATE




TOP TEMPLATE

Gather your supplies

- 2 fresh lemons, for dried peel
- •1 cup bicarb soda
- 1/2 cup Epsom salts
- Lemon, peppermint and rosemary essential oil blend
 - Dried mint leaves
 - Small clip-lid jar
 - · Baker's twine
- Small wooden spoon
- · Pack of place cards
- Red festive ribbon, optional
 - · Craft glue

You'll also need

Scissors; black marker pen; hole puncher

Here's how

STEP I Grate lemon peel. Put peel on a baking paperlined tray in the oven at 80°C fan-forced (100°C conventional) for about 10 minutes. Cool. Or, to retain



yellow colour, heat peel in microwave between sheets of paper towel, in 1 minute bursts, until dried, turning over paper towel each time.

STEP 2 Put bicarb, salts, 5-20 drops of essential oil, a sprinkling of dried mint and dried lemon peel in a clean, dry bowl. Stir with a wooden spoon to combine.

STEP 3 Spoon foot soak into jar. Label foot soak on card, write ingredients on

inside and punch a hole in corner of card. Tie twine around jar 3 times, winding around spoon to attach to jar. Thread twine through card hole and knot to secure. Wrap ribbon around jar and glue one end over top of other end for a seamless look.

Note: Only use once or twice a week to avoid drying out your skin, and do not

use if you have open cuts.



IT'SA WRAP!

Anyone can achieve this gift-wrap hack. Measure circumference and height of gift, allowing for overlap at sides and adding 7cm to height. Cut paper to suit. Overlap left and right sides at centre back, securing overlap with double-sided tape. Fold up 4cm at base, press fold, then unfold. Open bottom and create a triangular point on one side by pushing side fold in toward centre so side crease is even with 4cm fold line. Press to mark folds of triangular point. Repeat opposite. Fold both flaps toward centre so flaps overlap, tape to secure. Sit bag up, put filler and gift inside. For top enclosure, fold to form a flap, double-tape to secure, thread ribbon around and tie a bow.



Preparation time 10 mins Cooking time 18 mins Makes 12

½ baguette, sliced on an angle
2 Tbsp extra virgin olive oil
500g cherries, pitted
½ bunch thyme sprigs, plus extra
250g ricotta
80g feta
1 clove garlic, crushed

until cherries begin to blister. Cool. **STEP 3** Meanwhile, in a medium bowl, whip ricotta, feta and garlic. Season. Spread whipped ricotta over crostini, top with cherries, drizzle with cherry pan juices and serve with extra thyme.

Preparation time 15 mins Cooking time 15 mins Makes 16

16 rosemary sprigs, cut to 12cm long
700g sirloin beef, 2-3cm cubes
16 large green prawns, peeled and

Preparation time 15 mins plus overnight freezing Cooking time nil Serves 8-10

560g can lychees in syrup 24 small mint leaves, plus extra, to serve Pulp of 10 passionfruit



300ml dark rum, chilled 1 lemon, thinly sliced 2 x 1.25L bottles orange and passionfruit sparkling mineral water, chilled

STEP 1 Drain lychees, put liquid in a jug. Add 1/2 cup water to jug and stir to combine. Pour into two 12-hole ice cube trays. Put a mint leaf in each; freeze overnight. Cut lychees in half, transfer to a bowl. Cover and refrigerate. STEP 2 When ready to serve, strain passionfruit pulp through a sieve and reserve 2 tablespoons of seeds. Return seeds to juice, discard remaining seeds. STEP 3 Divide rum, passionfruit juice and seeds, lychees, lemon and mineral water between 2 large serving jugs, stir to combine. Top with extra mint. **STEP 4** Just before serving, turn out ice cubes from tray and add to jugs. Serve punch immediately.



SNAPPER CEVICHE WITH TORTILLA CHIPS

Preparation time 10 mins plus 30 mins marinating Cooking time 10 mins Serves 6

8 corn tortillas
Olive oil spray
500g skinless saddletail snapper
fillets, diced into 1cm cubes
1 small red onion, diced
1 cup lime juice, plus lime wedges,
to serve
1 mango, diced
1 cup coriander leaves
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground
black pepper, to season

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 180°C fan-forced (200°C conventional). Line an oven tray with baking paper. Cut tortillas into small triangles and spread out on tray. Spray with oil, bake for 10 minutes or until tortillas are crisp. Set aside to cool.

step 2 Meanwhile, in a medium, non-metallic bowl, combine snapper, red onion and lime juice. Mix well to ensure snapper is coated in lime juice. Cover and refrigerate for 30 minutes or until opaque. Pour out excess juice. step 3 When ready to serve, add mango and coriander to snapper mixture. Season. Serve ceviche with tortilla chips and lime wedges.



ROAST CARROT, LEMON AND GRAIN SALAD

Preparation time 10 mins Cooking time 30 mins Serves 6-8

3 bunches mixed heirloom Dutch carrots, unpeeled, scrubbed

1/3 cup extra virgin olive oil, plus extra
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper, to season

1/4 cup buckwheat
1 cup pearl couscous
13/4 cups water
3/4 bunch flat-leaf parsley, leaves picked, half coarsely chopped
Juice and finely grated zest of 1 lemon
3/4 cup Greek yoghurt, to serve

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 200°C fan-forced (220°C conventional). Line an oven tray with baking paper. Add carrots, drizzle with 2 tablespoons of the oil, season and bake for 25-30 minutes or until golden.

STEP 2 Meanwhile, heat a medium saucepan on medium heat. Add buckwheat and toast for 2-3 minutes. Transfer to a bowl and set aside.

STEP 3 Add 2 teaspoons of the oil to the same pan. Add couscous and toast on medium heat, stirring, for 2 minutes or until just golden. Add water and bring to a simmer. Cover with a lid and simmer on low for 10 minutes. Remove lid, cook for a further 2 minutes or until liquid has absorbed and couscous is cooked. Fluff with a fork and add to buckwheat. Add chopped parsley, juice, zest and

remaining olive oil. **STEP 4** Serve carrots with grains, yoghurt, remaining parsley and drizzle with extra oil.



TOMATO, PROSCIUTTO, BURRATA AND PINE NUT SALAD

Preparation time 10 mins Cooking time nil Serves 6-8

6 mixed heirloom tomatoes
2 Tbsp white balsamic vinegar
100g prosciutto, thinly sliced
1/4 bunch basil, leaves picked
2 fresh burrata
2 Tbsp pine nuts, toasted
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground
black pepper, to season

STEP 1 Thickly slice half of the tomatoes; cut remaining into wedges. **STEP 2** On a platter, arrange tomato, drizzle with balsamic, top with prosciutto, basil and burrata. Sprinkle with pine nuts. Season and serve.









1000-LAYER DUCK FAT POTATOES

Preparation time 15 mins Cooking time 1 hour and 10 mins Serves 8

2kg large sebago potatoes, peeled 150g duck fat, melted 3 rosemary sprigs, leaves picked and finely chopped 4 cloves garlic, thinly sliced Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper, to season ½ bunch thyme, sprigs picked

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 200°C fan-forced (220°C conventional).
Lightly grease a 25 x 20cm baking dish.
STEP 2 Using a mandolin, thinly slice potatoes lengthways (approx. 3-5mm).
Transfer to a large bowl, toss with duck fat, rosemary and garlic, ensuring potatoes are well coated. Season.
STEP 3 Layer potatoes lengthways in dish so they sit upright and snug.
Roast for 1 hour and 10 minutes, until golden and crisp, covering loosely with foil if they become too brown.
STEP 4 Remove from oven and rest for 10 minutes. Serve with thyme sprigs.



WATERMELON, POMEGRANATE AND FETA SALAD

Preparation time 10 mins Cooking time nil Serves 6-8

1/4 watermelon, cut into wedges
100g marinated feta in oil, drained,
oil reserved
4 green figs, halved or quartered
1 pomegranate, seeds removed
1/2 bunch mint, leaves picked
2 Tbsp pomegranate molasses
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground
black pepper, to season

STEP 1 Arrange watermelon, drained feta, figs, pomegranate seeds and mint on a platter.

STEP 2 Combine pomegranate molasses and 1 tablespoon of the reserved feta oil in a bowl, and whisk to combine. Season, then drizzle dressing over salad and serve.



SAGE, PANCETTA AND GARLIC BREAD-STUFFED CHICKEN

Preparation time 15 mins Cooking time 1 hour 45 mins Serves 6-8

1.6kg whole free-range chicken
¼ cup extra virgin olive oil, plus extra 2 Tbsp
2 bunches sage, leaves picked
250g piece of pancetta, finely diced
400g storebought garlic bread
1 free-range egg, lightly whisked
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper, to season
250ml chicken stock

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 180°C fan-forced (200°C conventional). Pat chicken dry with paper towel and put in a roasting pan.

STEP 2 Meanwhile, heat oil in a medium frypan on medium heat. Fry 12 sage leaves for 10 seconds or until vibrant green and crispy. Drain on paper towel. Add pancetta to frypan and cook for 7-10 minutes or until fat has rendered and pancetta is beginning to crisp. STEP 3 Pulse garlic bread in a food processor to fine crumbs. Reserve 1 cup crumbs for sauce and add remaining crumbs to pan with pancetta. Cook for 8-10 minutes or until golden, stirring occasionally. Coarsely chop remaining sage and stir through mixture. Remove from heat and remove 1/2 cup of crumbs for topping. Stir egg through remaining crumb mixture to form stuffing. Season. STEP 4 Fill chicken cavity with stuffing. Tie legs with kitchen string and tuck in wings. Drizzle with extra oil, bake for

1 hour and 15 minutes or until cooked. STEP 5 To make bread sauce, remove chicken from roasting pan and transfer to plate, loosely covered with foil. Put pan over medium heat and add first lot of reserved uncooked bread crumbs. Cook, stirring, for 3 minutes. Add stock using wooden spoon, scraping any bits from bottom of pan. Simmer for 5 minutes or until starting to brown. Cool slightly before transferring to a blender. Blitz until smooth and thickened, add more stock if necessary. STEP 6 Serve chicken with reserved cooked crumb mixture, fried sage leaves and bread sauce.



BAKED HAM WITH CARDAMOM, CHERRY AND PORT WINE GLAZE

Preparation time 15 mins Cooking time 1 hour 45 mins Serves 12-14

9kg leg of ham
1½ cups brown sugar
½ cup port
1 cup BBQ sauce
2 tsp ground cardamom powder
600g frozen cherries, defrosted

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 160°C fan-forced (180°C conventional). Use a sharp knife to cut around rind, 10cm from shank end. Run thumb under rind to separate from fat. Slowly peel back and discard rind. Score fat at 1.5cm intervals, ensure you don't cut through to meat. Score in opposite direction to create diamond pattern. Wrap shank in foil and put ham on a large baking tray lined with foil and baking paper. STEP 2 Add sugar, port, sauce and cardamom to a medium saucepan on medium heat. Cook, stirring for 5 minutes or until sugar has dissolved. Add cherries and bring to simmer. Reduce heat to low and simmer for 8-10 minutes or until glaze thickens slightly. Remove from heat and use a slotted spoon to remove cherries for later.

STEP 3 Brush ham with $\frac{1}{3}$ of the glaze. Bake for 1 hour and 30 minutes, basting every half hour with glaze until ham is golden. Serve with reserved cherries and any remaining glaze.



ROASTED PORK RACK WITH MAPLE PEACHES

Preparation time 10 mins plus chilling Cooking time 1 hour 15 mins Serves 8

2.6kg rack of pork (8 cutlets)
2 Tbsp extra virgin olive oil
Sea-salt flakes and freshly ground black pepper, to season
6 yellow peaches, halved, stones removed
8 purple shallots, peeled
2 garlic bulbs, halved horizontally
½ bunch of lemon thyme sprigs
¼ cup maple syrup

put in a ceramic dish. Refrigerate, uncovered, for at least 2 hours or overnight (if time permits).

STEP 2 Preheat oven to 220°C fan-forced (240°C conventional).

Preparation time 15 mins plus 4 hours 30 mins chilling Cooking time nil Serves 8-10

400g gingerbread biscuits
160g unsalted butter, melted
500g cream cheese, softened slightly
1/4 cup honey, plus extra 1 Tbsp
4 mangoes, thinly sliced
1/4 cup Sunbeam Australian Pistachios,
roughly chopped, to serve

STEP 1 Put biscuits in a food processor and process until coarse crumbs. Add melted butter and continue to process until fine crumbs and combined. Spoon mixture into a lightly greased 35 x 10cm rectangle loose-based fluted tart pan. Using the back of a spoon, push mixture into base and up sides of pan. FROZEN BURNT BRANDY BUTTER CHRISTMAS PUDDING

Preparation time 10 mins plus 4 hours soaking and freezing
Cooking time 10 mins
Serves 6-8

1½ cups Sunbeam Mixed Fruit
 ¼ cup brandy, warmed
 60g unsalted butter
 2L good-quality vanilla ice-cream, softened
 50g honeycomb, coarsely chopped, plus extra shards, to serve
 1 cup caster sugar
 ½ cup water

STEP1 Combine mixed fruit and 2 tablespoons of the brandy in bowl. Soak for 1 hour or overnight. **STEP 2** Melt butter in medium frypan on medium heat. Cook, swirling pan occasionally, for 2 minutes or until foam becomes golden. Add remaining brandy and bring to simmer (take care not to let it catch on fire on a gas stovetop). Remove from heat, cool for 5 minutes. STEP 3 Transfer ice-cream into a large bowl. Fold through soaked fruit mixture, honeycomb and butter mixture. Put in a 1.5L pudding dish, lightly greased and lined with plastic wrap, ensuring wrap overhangs edge by 15cm. Smooth ice-cream mixture, cover with excess wrap. Freeze for 2-3 hours or until set. **STEP 4** Meanwhile, line a large oven tray with baking paper and put on a wire rack. Stir sugar and water in a large saucepan on low heat until dissolved. Increase heat to high and bring to boil. Boil, not stirring, for 6-8 minutes or until golden. Remove from heat and pour over prepared tray to form thin, even toffee. Set aside for 20 minutes to firm completely. **STEP 5** Put base of pudding dish in a bowl of warm water to help loosen. Gently pull out plastic wrap to release pudding. Invert onto a serving plate and remove plastic wrap. Gently

Serve pudding topped with extra honeycomb and broken toffee shards.



STRAWBERRY 'SPLICE' JELLY BUNDT

Preparation time 20 mins plus overnight chilling Cooking time nil Serves 8

3 Tbsp powdered gelatine, plus extra 2 tsp
1/2 cup warm water
250g cream cheese, at room temperature
395g condensed milk
600ml thickened cream, plus extra 300ml
2 x 85g pkts strawberry jelly crystals

STEP 1 Sprinkle the powdered gelatine over warm water. Gently whisk to dissolve and set aside for 10 minutes to bloom. Microwave on HIGH (100% power) for 40 seconds.

2 cups boiling water

2 tsp dried rose petals

200ml cold water

paddle attachment, beat cream cheese and milk for 2 minutes. Add cream and beat for 1 minute or until smooth. Pour in dissolved gelatine, mix for 10 seconds until incorporated. Pour mixture into a 25cm-wide greased bundt pan. Smooth top, put in fridge for 4 hours or until set.

STEP 3 Combine jelly crystals and extra 2 teaspoons of gelatine into a large, heatproof jug. Stir in boiling water, until dissolved. Add cold water, set aside to cool for 20 minutes.

STEP 4 Remove bundt pan from fridge. Carefully separate white layer from sides of pan and invert onto a board or plate. Clean bundt pan, dry thoroughly and lightly grease with canola oil cooking spray. Immediately flip set cream cheese mixture back into clean pan.

STEP 5 Pour cooled jelly into bundt pan. Carefully pull cream cheese mixture away from sides and middle so liquid can move below (white layer should begin to float on top of jelly). Refrigerate overnight to completely set. STEP 6 Put pan in hot water for 3-5 seconds to loosen jelly, then flip onto a platter. Whip extra cream to soft peaks, transfer to a piping bag fitted with a small fluted nozzle. Decorate jelly with cream and rose petals. Serve. ■

STRAWBERRY SNOWFLAKE COOKIES

Preparation

time 1 hour plus chilling Cooking time 20 mins Makes 24

150g unsalted butter, softened
1/2 cup caster sugar
1 tsp vanilla essence
1 free-range egg yolk
11/2 cups plain flour, sifted, plus extra,
for dusting
1 tsp Queen Strawb'ry & Cream
Colour And Flavour For Icing

600g box white ready-to-roll icing (fondant) Pure icing sugar, sifted, for dusting Pink food colouring

2 Tbsp strawberry jam, warmed

STEP 1 Beat butter, sugar and vanilla in bowl of an electric mixer until pale and creamy. Beat in egg yolk until combined. Stir in flour to form a dough.

STEP 2 Divide dough into 2 portions. Transfer 1 portion to a separate bowl and stir in Strawb'ry & Cream Colour And Flavour. Flatten each portion into a flat disc on clean bench. Cut both portions into thick strips. Layer dough, alternating plain and pink strips, then press together and fold a few times for a marbled effect. Flatten into a disc. Wrap in plastic wrap and refrigerate for 1 hour, or until firm. Preheat oven to 160°C fan-forced (180°C conventional).

STEP 3 Roll out dough between 2 sheets of baking paper until 5mm thick. Lightly dust Snowflake cookie cutter with flour. Cut dough into shapes with cutter (without stamp).

Put shapes on baking paper-lined trays about 3cm apart. (Re-dust cutter with flour as needed to prevent sticking.) Bake for about 10 minutes or until cookies are very pale golden around edges. Cool on trays for 5 minutes, then transfer to wire racks to cool. Repeat with dough trimmings until all dough is used. STEP 4 Knead icing on a clean bench lightly dusted with icing sugar until smooth. Divide into 3 portions. Tint pale pink, mid-pink and dark pink with pink food colouring. Roll out icing, 1 portion at a time, between 2 sheets of baking paper until 5mm thick. Lightly dust Snowflake cookie cutter and stamp with icing sugar. Cut icing into shapes, pressing imprint firmly. (Re-dip cutter

STEP 5 Brush biscuits with jam. Top with snowflake icing shapes. Serve.

and stamp in icing sugar as needed to



prevent sticking.)

BUTTERCREAM
250g unsalted butter, softened

STEP 1 Preheat oven to 160°C fan-forced (180°C conventional). Spray a 6-hole ³/₄-cup capacity Texas muffin pan with oil.

STEP 2 Beat butter, sugar and maple syrup in bowl of an electric mixer until pale and creamy. Beat in eggs one at a time, until combined.

STEP 3 Combine milk and bicarb soda in a small jug.

STEP 4 Stir combined sifted flour and spices, and milk mixture into butter mixture in 2 batches, stirring until smooth and combined. Spoon evenly into prepared muffin pan.

STEP 5 Bake for 50 minutes, or until cakes are golden and cooked when tested with a skewer. Stand cakes in pan for 5 minutes, then loosen edges and turn onto a wire rack. Pierce top of hot cakes all over with a skewer. Brush with extra maple syrup. Cool.

with icing sugar. Lightly dust Santa cookie cutter and stamp with icing sugar. Cut out 6 Santa shapes, pressing imprint firmly. Arrange on a baking paper-lined tray. Before the icing sets, sprinkle red lustre over Santas, brush off excess with a pastry brush. Sprinkle with sugar crystals. Set aside to firm for 30 minutes.

STEP 7 For Buttercream, in an electric mixer fitted with a paddle attachment, beat butter until pale. Gradually add icing sugar mixture, beating on low until combined. Increase speed to high and beat until light and fluffy, adding a little milk if needed. Tint red using colouring. Transfer to a piping bag fitted with a fluted nozzle.

STEP 8 Trim any peaked tops from cooled cakes, pipe frosting over cakes in small pipes. Top with Santa icing shapes.



CARAMEL AND PISTACHIO SANDWICH COOKIES

Preparation time 1 hour plus chilling Cooking time 40 mins Makes 24 sandwich cookies

250g unsalted butter, softened
3/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar
1 tsp vanilla essence
1 free-range egg yolk
21/4 cups plain flour, sifted, plus extra,
for dusting

STEP 3 Roll out 1 dough portion between 2 sheets of baking paper until 5mm thick. Lightly dust Merry Christmas cookie cutter and stamp with flour. Cut dough into shapes with cutter, pressing imprint firmly. Put shapes on baking paper-lined trays about 3cm apart. (Re-dust cutter and stamp with flour as needed to prevent sticking.) Bake for 15-20 minutes or until cookies are lightly golden around edges. Cool on trays for 5 minutes, then transfer to wire racks to cool.

Repeat with remaining dough portion and dough trimmings until all the dough is used.

Silicone baking sheet; roller; bamboo skewer; cake cooling rack; flat and liner paintbrushes; kitchen paper towel; makeup sponge; lint-free cloth; scissors

NOTES

- Wrap any unused air-dry clay in plastic wrap and place it in a ziplock bag and an airtight container to help prevent it drying out.
- Two-piece cookie cutter stamps are used here (shop the set on page 37).

Here's how

STEP 1 Cut a piece of airdry clay and knead to soften and make it more pliable.
STEP 2 Working on silicone baking sheet, roll out the clay to about 4mm thick.
STEP 3 Press the cookie cutter into the clay – do not remove the cutter.

cutter, press stamp into clay firmly. For inked decos, see instructions far left. Peel away excess clay, then remove cutter and stamp. Use excess clay straight away or store to reuse later. STEP 5 To create a hole for a hanger, push a small straw or flat end of a skewer into the clay. If making the wreath (page 35), make 2 holes, opposite each other for threading wire. If using a straw, lift it straight out. If using a skewer, keep skewer in place, gently swirling to slowly enlarge the hole. Aim for a hole large enough to pass wire or a large-eyed needle with string, cord or narrow ribbon attached. STEP 6 With your palm face up, place shaped decoration on the fingers of your hand then, using your other hand, use a damp finger to smooth outside edge of the clay shape. **STEP 7** Put your clay decoration on cake cooling rack and let dry. It can take up to 2 to 3 days to dry thoroughly, depending on the weather and humidity. STEP 8 Optional: If painting your decorations, follow instructions below. STEP 9 Use your clay

TREE TRIMS

You'll also need

String/cord; wooden beads; large-eyed needle (to suit hole/ beads/string or cord); 10mm-wide ribbon in colour of choice; hot glue gun/glue sticks

STEP 1 Refer to Air-dry clay decorations instructions (left) to make desired number of ornaments. STEP 2 For each tree trim, paint 3 wooden beads with a light coat or two of white acrylic paint. You will find it easier to do this if you thread the beads on a skewer then balance the skewer on a bowl before using a small makeup sponge or mini stencil pouncing tool to apply the paint. Let paint dry. STEP 3 Double a 50cm length of string/cord, then make a holding knot 10cm from the looped end. Thread both loose ends of string/cord through the 3 beads and knot to hold them in place. Pass 1 loose end of string/cord through hole in clay decoration and knot with the other loose end at the back of the clay decoration. Snip excess string/cord.

PAINTED DECORATIONS

Follow Steps 1 - 7 of the Air-dry clay decorations (above), then apply a coat of Mod Podge and let dry.

Using a small, flat paintbrush, paint desired sections of the surface, such as Santa's hat, coat and/or sack or the reindeer nose. Use a damp makeup sponge to clean paint that may have gone outside the lines. Let paint dry.

STEP 4 Hot glue a ribbon bow onto the knot directly below the last bead.



GORGEOUS GARLAND

You'll also need

Fine gold wire; LED string lights (warm white light); gold leaf-shaped ribbon

Here's how

step 1 Refer to Air-dry clay decorations instructions (opposite page) to make desired number of ornaments to suit the length of garland.

STEP 2 Work with a long length of fine gold wire (about double the desired garland length) and allow for a 20cm tail at each end. STEP 3 Working on a table. leave a 20cm tail (for attaching) at one end and begin to string wire through the hole of a clay decoration. Twist wire around itself 2 to 3 times directly above the decoration to keep it in place. Repeat this step, spacing your decorations evenly across the wire. Leave a tail and cut any excess wire.

STEP 4 Lay your garland on a table, then wrap LED string lights around

the wire followed by gold leaf-shaped ribbon. Keep ribbon in place with a twist of wire at each end. Use the loose tail ends to attach to a hook or similar to secure the garland.



COUNTING DOWN THE DAYS

You'll also need

A2 picture frame; foamcore board; wadding; linen fabric; place cards or tags; single hole punch; 38mm wig or craft T-pins; clear packaging tape; gold cardstock; gold number stickers: tweezers; glue stick; mounting tape; mini bristle brush tree: 50mm-wide satin and organza white ribbon: 3mm-wide to 5mm-wide ribbons: shank button/s; large and small folley bells in colours to suit: mini baubles: fine gold wire; miniature glitter bottle; preserved flowers; faux leaves: self-adhesive stars; small gift-wrapped parcel; miniature paper fan wheel decorations; spray adhesive; needle and thread

Here's how

STEP 1 Refer to Air-

dry clay decorations instructions (opposite page) to make desired number of ornaments. STEP 2 Dismantle an A2 picture frame. Cut foamcore to fit inside frame. Spray adhesive onto foamcore, then press wadding on top. Trim wadding to size. Cut linen to about 7.5cm larger all around than foamcore. Stretching it taut, cover wadding with linen and tape the excess fabric to the back of the foamcore. Reassemble frame.

STEP 3 Punch a hole at centre top of each place card or tag. On the back of each place card/tag, write a Christmas sentiment or have token trinkets, lollies, chocolate or adventures that can be 'redeemed'. Use T-pins to pin evenly spaced place cards/tags to the frame.

STEP 4 Determine which place card/tag will feature a stamped clay decoration then cut and paste gold card onto place card/tag, leaving room at the bottom for advent dates. Use mounting tape to stick clay decoration on top.

sTEP 5 To create a ribbon flower, fold 70cm x 50mm-wide satin and/or organza ribbon in half lengthwise. Tucking in the raw end of ribbon and catching front and back of ribbon, use needle and thread to work running stitch along edge of ribbon, partially gathering ribbon as you go. As you near the end, tuck in the raw edge and continue working

running stitch to the end. Gather the thread taut to create a ribbon circlet and stitch to secure. Stitch a shank button to the centre. Mount or hot glue to place card/tag.

STEP 6 Using a dab of hot glue, attach preserved flowers and/or faux leaves, organza ribbon bows with a glitter bottle, miniature Christmas ornaments such as a mini bristle tree onto place cards/tags. Trim faux leaves and preserved flowers with 3mm-wide ribbon bows, using hot glue to attach.

STEP 7 Use mounting tape, attach a small gift-wrapped parcel, and mini fan wheel decorations (overlapping them if desired) onto place cards/tags.

STEP 8 Dangle Christmas folley bells and mini baubles from cord hung from the T-bar pins.

STEP 9 Stick self-adhesive glitter stars to place cards/tags.

STEP 10 Using tweezers, attach gold number stickers (1-24) to each place card/tag and let the countdown to Christmas begin! ■

CREPE PAPER **POINSETTIA**

Gather your supplies

- Crepe paper in assorted colours heavy-weight is best
- · Boyle Craft Glue, quick drying
 - Florist wire
 - · Hot glue gun
 - Florist tape
- Glitter glass, rose gold or to suit

Note

Colour match your floristry wire and florist tape to your tree - white for silver, green for an evergreen tree.

Here's how

STEP 1 Cut 16 squares to measure 12.5 x 12.5cm out of crepe paper (e.g. 6 in coral and 10 in light pink). Cut each square on the diagonal to create 32 triangles.


STEP 2 Put 1 triangle on top of another, long sides together. Fold back to create a diagonal 'seam' so lines of crepe paper point in opposite directions and create a V pattern for poinsettia 'veins'. Glue just long sides of seam together with craft glue. Let dry. Repeat this step for remaining 30 triangles.

STEP 3 When dry, open the triangle pieces and crease centres.

STEP 4 Use templates (above) to trace 6 large, 6 medium and 4 small petals on crepe pieces; cut out.

CREPE PAPER POINSETTIA DIAGRAMS РНОТОСОРУ TEMPLATES (ENLARGE OR REDUCE TEMPLATES IE DESIDED) SMALL LARGE MEDIUM STEP 5 Cut 12 pieces of florist wire, each measuring 7.5cm. Hot glue to back of large and medium petals. STEP 6 Gather medium petals into a flower shape, petals slightly overlapping. Add large petals underneath, lining up points of large petals in between those of medium petals. Wrap stems together with florist tape. STEP 7 In the centre of the flower, hot glue the 4 small petals on top of the medium petals, add a dollop of craft glue (about the size of a 5-cent piece), sprinkle with glitter and let dry.




